Zutphen, located along the Berkel and the IJssel rivers, is one of the oldest cities in the Netherlands. The Hanseatic City has a rich history, many traces of which can be seen in its centre.



Its waterside location has bestowed Zutphen with many treasures. Churches, parts of fortifications, stately warehouses, and merchant homes are still around to be admired in the historic city centre. This beautiful architecture forms the backdrop for a lovely mix of shops, restaurants, events, and cultural attractions.

### Unique shops

Pay a visit to the unique stores and specialist shops and take a breather at one of the many casual dining options, restaurants, and bars. You are also welcome to stop by the galleries and studios that you will see all over the city. Zutphen is a great place to be.



### Pass by the most beautiful spots on an electric boat

During a voyage on an electric boat, you will discover the most beautiful spots along the canals and the Berkel River. This boat will ferry you past Zutphen's historic monuments for about 1 hour, while the captain tells you about the history of Zutphen in his own unique way. The electric boats sail from April to October. Cruises begin daily at 11.00 am, 1.00 pm, and 3.00 pm. There is an additional trip on Saturdays at 4.30 pm.

### Impressive church with its unusual Librije

The 79-metre-tall tower of the impressive St. Walburga's Church on the 's-Gravenhof offers you a stunning view over the city. In the church, there are many things to admire, including the 14th-century chandelier, the baptismal font, and the stunning frescoes. The church also houses the Librije, a unique, medieval chained library. St. Walburga's Church and the Librije are open from the middle of April to September and during the autumn holidays. (Individual arrangements can be made for groups outside of opening hours.)

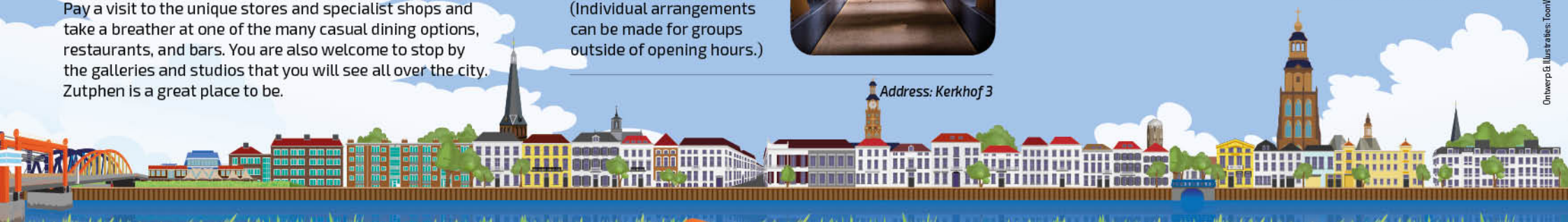

### Visit the new Musea Zutphen (Zutphen Museums)

In May 2017, the Musea Zutphen will reopen in a national monument, the palatial urban estate of Hof van Heeckeren. History, cultural record, visual art, and current events come together in the new home of the museums and the archaeological service. The Stedelijk Museum Zutphen (Zutphen City Museum) tells the "tale of Zutphen" in its medieval cellars, using unique objects from the museum, archaeological, and archival collections. Museum Henriette Polak, on the first floor, holds true to its name as the museum for modern classical painting and sculpture in the Netherlands, with an eye for new talent.
